It is a great privilege and pleasure to announce Joe Kutter as the person chosen by unanimous vote of the Ministers Council Executive Committee to serve as Acting Executive Director, beginning on September 1. The Executive Committee was authorized by Senate 2007 to finalize the selection on behalf of the constituency. Since last summer the Personnel Committee has received and reviewed names of potential candidates and recommended Joe Kutter.

Joe Kutter's ministry is well known to us as members of the Ministers Council: 39 years of pastoral ministry during which he served five congregations. He has also served as a seminary trustee, President of the Ministers Council, as chaplain to the General Board and General Board Executive Committee, and in a variety of regional and community leadership roles.

Joe's numerous leadership capacities with the organization, as well as his work on the Together in Ministry Steering Committee, equip him superbly for the role. The next stage of the Ministers Council strategy is a Lilly-funded project for organizational capacity building through resourcing and strengthening constituent Council leadership. His gifts make him the ideal leader for that phase of the work.

Joe will serve the Ministers Council for two or three years as the American Baptist Churches USA pursues a process of restructuring.
