

**Relevant and Responsive—A
Chaplain's Perspective**

Spiritual care providers have long labored in diverse settings—prisons, long-term care facilities, prisons, hospitals, military settings, businesses, and nursing homes. Under Spiritual Care Week's 2022 banner, "Relevant and Responsive," from October 23-29, many of these institutions will recognize and honor the contributions of their chaplains, pastoral counselors and others who collaborate with team members to ensure holistic care.

The week can be an opportunity for team members in healthcare settings to express their appreciation for the chaplains among them, especially those who care for patients and families in very challenging areas like pregnancy loss. Pregnancy loss can be difficult for staff members and physicians as well. Often labor and delivery nurses are in the same age cohort as the patient; physicians may have chosen their specialty area, in part at least, because it's usually a

happy place within healthcare until the tragedy of pregnancy loss occurs.

The document being voted upon is being ratified by Chapter votes and is not subject to further editorial revisions. Corey recently authored this [support letter](#) as we approach the deadline for ratification, December 31, 2022.
