

LEARNING GUIDE FOR NEW CODE OF ETHICS -



Devotional Study Seeds from Rev. Dr. Charlotte W. Myers, Leadership Team

Rooted to Create New Life Jeremiah 17:7 – 8

The Back Story

The outward appearance of a person or situation may not tell the whole story. For example, Jeremiah declared God's message repeatedly. Yet, the people were not moved and did not listen. The result was Jeremiah was poor and deprived and had no material success. Yet, regardless of the personal cost, he faithfully spoke the word of God. He simply stated, "Repent and turn to God, or He *will* punish." As pastors and preachers, we, too may wonder why the Spirit keeps pressing us to speak up. Why we cannot be comfortable telling people only what they want to hear. Yet, the Lord continues to send us messages of

such urgency and necessity for change; and like Jeremiah, we too have a responsibility to bring God's word to the people.
