Throughout this past year, the Ministers Council leadership team has been reflecting on the tree mentioned in Jeremiah 17:7-8, lingering for a time on sending out our roots by the stream, not being anxious in the year of drought, not fearing when the heat comes, and never ceasing to bear fruit.

As we enter into the season of Advent and journey toward Christmas, I am struck by the phrase in this passage noting that the tree's "leaves shall stay green." It has been a long-standing tradition in parts of the world where evergreen trees grow to bring them inside as decoration during the long, cold, dark winter months because their leaves and needles do not turn brown or shed. Over the centuries, this tradition has been adopted by Christians all over the world who call the evergreen trees (real and fake) that they bring inside Christmas trees and decorate them with candles, lights, garlands, and ornaments as they celebrate the birth of Christ.

Legend has it that Martin Luther, who lived in Germany where evergreen trees are native, used these trees whose leaves stayed green to teach about the everlasting, never ending love of God. They have become a symbol of hope and new life in the midst of harsh experiences like those a winter season can bring. And so I wonder, as we journey through this season of Advent, what practices we might embody to remind us of the never-ending love of God and how we can share that love with others. 

Expect Miracles

Consider a time when something remarkable happened – something miraculous even – that was beyond your full comprehension. Where can you find God in that moment?



Miracles don't always come in the packages we think they might, or should, or even hope that they will.

It can be tricky to talk about miracles. We want to live out our faith with FAITH – leaving room for the mystery of God – while also trying not to say anything too simple or thoughtless about God that doesn't hold up in the midst of incredible pain and tragedy.

We want to be able to say something meaningful about God while acknowledging that anything we say is truly inadequate and limited – and so we often err on the side of saying nothing.
