Don Ng said, “Camino” means “the way”. While the historic Camino de Santiago takes place in Spain, “caminos” can happen anywhere. You can have a “camino” in your own neighborhood. One of the distinctions of the *Camino de Santiago* is walking for a long time. This is not to tire you out or make it too formidable for many to do it. Rather, going for a long walk enables focused and contemplative thinking which may lead to a re-purposing of our spiritual life.

Since Lauren and I are not only daughter-father, we are blessed with the relationship of being American Baptist ministerial colleagues. Let's say we have much to talk about! In August, we walked the final segment of the Camino Portugues to arrive at the Cathedral Santiago de Compostela. Join us, as we share the value of what a long walk may do in your ministry."
