What Is Spiritual Directions?

Spiritual direction is "help given by one person to another which enables that person to pay attention to God's personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship." (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, The Practice of Spiritual Direction)

Spiritual direction is the practice of "holy listening and tending to the soul" where you learn to become more attentive to how and where God is leading and guiding you. Through the practice of spiritual direction, a Spiritual Director listens and helps one notice God's presence in their daily lives.

Over the years, my journey has been marked by many practices of spiritual formation, including that of spiritual direction. In times of stress and chaos, especially amidst life's transitions, "direction" has been a centering source calling me back to the practice of listening and discernment of God's voice and my own inner voice. At times, it has been liberating by un-earthing deeply held emotions and healing unresolved conflicts. In a word, direction has been "restorative". -- Randolph T. Miller, Medford, Oregon
