ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MINISTERS COUNCIL “Servants of the Jubilee” June 17-19, 2017

Chapter representatives and members of the national Leadership Team met prior to the Mission Summit for worship, fellowship and business. Attendees shared chapter news, approved a provisional budget for 2020, elected officers and voted on a number of business items regarding living into priorities and structure approved in Philadelphia in 2018. KEY DECISIONS/VOTES:

1. Because we are grateful for God’s providence known through our recent restructuring and mission discernment, we claim a “Year of Jubilee” for NATIONAL dues for 2020. (Our necessary 2019 dues continue to come in and be recorded for current year through October 31, 2019.) Local chapters will collect dues in 2020 as led.
2. We will be conducting a major outreach campaign to denominational ministers regarding the above, *with a renewed invitation to “Come and experience us NOW.”*
3. We will move from an “Annual Meeting” (long-held custom previously called “Senate”) to a Bi-ANNUAL meeting. The first Bi-Annual meeting will be held in 2020 at a time and location tba, and will be the setting for business conducted by Leadership Team and Chapter Representatives. On “odd number” years, we will continue having a program presence in conjunction with Mission Summit open to all ministerial leaders and seminarians.
4. We will develop a process by which recent recommendations to updating the Code of Ethics will be deliberated. (This was an action item from November 2018 meeting, and a sub-committee has begun working on this.)
5. Revised Standing Rules were adopted, and will be posted soon at the website.
