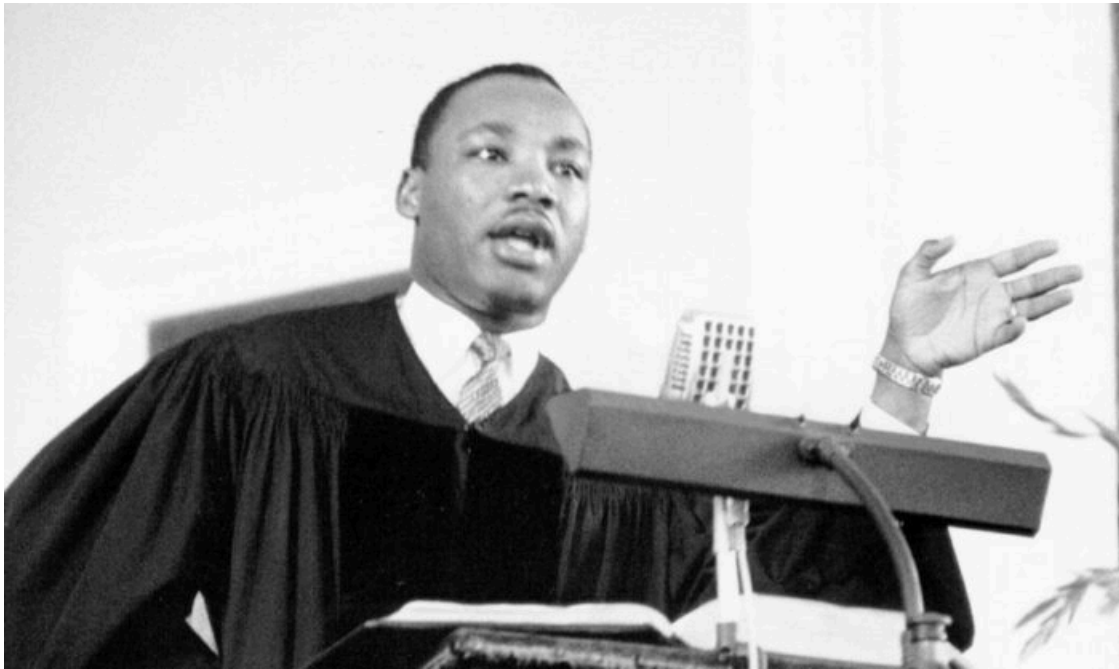

Faith in Action: Honoring Dr. King Through Service

A Day of Service is one way we honor Dr. King’s legacy—not as a memorial alone, but as a living practice. Whether through feeding ministries, advocacy, mentoring, care for creation, or acts of compassion often unseen, service becomes prayer with hands and feet.

For ministers and congregations, this day is also an invitation to teach and model a gospel that moves beyond words. It is a chance to engage all generations in the work of love, to partner with local organizations, and to bear witness to a faith that seeks the common good.

As Dr. King taught, greatness is found not in power, but in service. May our ministries continue to proclaim that truth—not only from our pulpits, but through lives poured out in love.

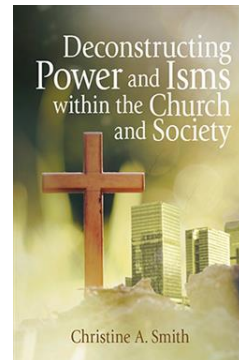
A Conversation with Rev. Dr. Christine A. Smith
